STATEMENT OF PRINCIPAL

The Equestrian Canada Federation (EC), the National Federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction. The EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation, and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices.
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Reviewing, revising, and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibiting procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

THE RULE BOOK

Exhibitors, Judges, and Show Officials are responsible for knowledge of the Rules. Both a complete knowledge of and compliance with the rules are essential, and all participants must be fully cognizant of all rules as well as class specifications in the division in which they compete. Full details of Horse Show operation - EC (including FEI) rules - list of recognized Judges - **other vital information is in the RULE BOOK** copyright for exclusive use of recognized shows. See current EC Rules and Amendments. Every individual is eligible to count points won at recognized EC Shows for Annual and Provincial Championship Awards. The current EC Rules and Amendments are presently in effect and have been used to compile the Rules and Regulations for this prize list. Passports are NOT required in a recognized "Breed" competition.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of the EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rules Book and the current A.H.A. Handbook and amendments. Therefore, it meets all requirements for eligibility of National Championship classes. In the case of any discrepancy, AHA rules will prevail and if not covered then the EC rules will apply. The Show Committee reserves the right to decide on any rule not covered by EC and/or A.H.A. (Article A602.2 EC Rule Book) All decisions made by the Show Committee are final.
2. All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Arabian Horse Association, the Equestrian Canada, and the Western Canadian Breeders Commission their officers, contract personnel or volunteers or any of its affiliates, the Westerner Park, their officers, officials and employees will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any exhibitor, his or her agent or employee, or to any horse or any article of any kind. The exhibitor will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury, to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify all parties listed above against any and all loss, damages, or liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of any entry form to the Entry Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.
3. Upon any act of discourtesy or disobedience to **any** official or volunteer of the Western Canadian Breeders Championship Horse Show on the part of any owner, groom, rider, driver, or handler may result in the immediate removal from the show of said person, at the discretion of the Show Commission and the owner will forfeit their entry fees. Such action will be reported to EC and AHA for disciplinary action. Official protests (\$100 cash fee) must be filed as per the current EC Rule Book.
4. The WCB Show Commission reserves for itself the power to remove any person or horse from the show without being liable for compensation of any kind.
5. The WCB Show Commission reserves the right to add to, amend, or decide any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error or make necessary alterations in the prize list and program.
6. Patterns & Orders of Go will be posted 24 hours prior to the each class.
7. The WCB Show Commission reserves the right to cancel any class with less than three (3) horses entered.
8. Potentially large classes may be split by the WCB Show Commission into a Section A and Section B with a final section should the numbers warrant such action.
9. **WCB Championship show chooses the option of using one ride for the 2018 dressage classes.**
10. No horse shall remain on the grounds if it is not entered in the WCB Show unless written permission is granted by Show Commission or the Calgary Committee - *exception Mare with foals at side.*
11. **Stallions are NOT permitted in Junior Showmanship, WalkTrot/Jog or Lead Line classes.**
12. **SELECT ATR **** see current AHA (Arabian Horse Association) for the leveling system and the EC Arabian section B1502.6 - It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to know the rules of each class/each division of each class they enter. Please read the changes for this category!**
Riders of Arabian, Half-Arabian or Anglo Arabian horses competing in the same section shall not be considered separately.
*If a rider is eligible to compete as a **Select** rider in a respective section on December 1, said eligibility remains throughout the competition year.*
13. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC.
14. Any horse entered in any class is required to pay the drug testing fee and may be selected for equine medication control testing. This includes all Breeding/In-Hand horses.
15. Grooms entering the ring are to appear neat, clean and suitably attired. (i.e. unmarked smock).
16. No person other than the officials, steward, attendants on duty, and the Judge of the class may enter the show ring without permission of the Judge.
17. Exhibitors are responsible for reporting all entries to the Gate Attendant five minutes before each respective class is called for showing and must enter the ring promptly when called. **Those who are not ready when called will not be allowed to enter the ring to compete. No fees will be refunded.**
18. Horses **shall not** be punished unnecessarily or severely anywhere on the Show Grounds. Rules regarding cruelty and abuse are covered by the EC Rule Book and will be enforced.
19. Any Exhibitor using a wrong back number or having no number may be excused or disqualified from the class at the discretion of the Judge of the class. No fees will be refunded.
20. Competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise rings – PLEASE COMPLY WITH THIS EC RULE as requested by EC which also means the Show Steward must enforce it. TWO Back Numbers have been issued for each horse. Please use the LARGE number for the Show Ring – exception – Dressage. (Article A814 EC Rule book)

21. All horses artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before coming into the Show Arena will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that an exhibitor has made or caused to be made a false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the Judge in the performance of his/her duties, that exhibitor shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting. In the case of any animal being disqualified the winner of the next succeeding prize shall take the prize that has been awarded to such animal and lowest prize in the class shall go to the reserve number.
22. No whips over 6 feet long, including snapper, may be used either inside or outside the ring by anyone when showing a Breeding/In Hand horse. Lashes or appendages of any kind are prohibited.
23. An approved helmet and harness **MUST** be worn in all over fence classes and Hunt Seat Equitation Not To Jump. All Juniors are strongly urged to wear hard hats until just before they enter the show ring without being penalized. See Protective Headgear Notice.
24. Hors Concours will **NOT** be allowed at this Championship show.

ENTRIES

1. Entries must be postmarked no later than **May 20, 2018**.

Post entries will be accepted until June 25, 2018 at double entry fee after the closing date of May 20, 2018.

2. Cancellation of entries for any reason after the closing date of May 20, 2018 will forfeit entry fees unless a suitable Veterinarian Certificate attesting to illness or injury is received, in writing, by the Show Secretary before 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 26, 2018. A \$25.00 processing charge will be retained. Office and number fees will not be refunded.
3. There will be a \$50.00 fee charged for any Returned Cheque. If the problem has not been corrected within 30 days a report will be submitted to AHA which could result in exclusion from any Regional, National or regular shows.
4. The Show Committee reserves the right to add to, amend, or decide any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error or make any necessary alterations in the prize list or show program.
5. The Show Steward shall have the full power to act for and on behalf of the Show Committee during the entire show.

******* IMPORTANT ***** PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING**

1. Please read all rules and forms before completing. Errors are costly to everyone.
2. Full entry fees must accompany all entries.
3. Entries must be complete and **include copies** of the following:
 - a) **current copy registration papers** - front & back for each horse entered
 - b) copy of **lease agreement** or **contract of sale** (if applicable)
 - c) copy of **membership cards** from **A.H.A.** and **EC** for each *owner, rider, handler, driver*. - Seniors and Youth
 - d) **EC Amateur** status (if applicable) – for all amateur competitors at 19yrs of age and over
 - e) **Parent/Guardian signature for any Minor on all signature lines.**

Entries will be considered incomplete if submitted without copies of registration papers and membership cards and will be assessed a fee of \$20.00 by the Show Secretary.

ELIGIBILITY to COMPETE IN THE CANADIAN ARABIAN BREEDERS CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

1. HORSES MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry (CAHR) or the Canadian Partbred Registry (CPAR) or the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) as recorded by the certificate of registration.
2. **Canadian Bred** as recorded by the certificate of registration **OR Canadian Owned** as recorded by the certificate of registration and be registered with the CAHR or CPAR.
3. Be properly entered in the Canadian Arabian Breeders Championship class prior to closing date of entries & have attached a photocopy of the CAHR or the CPAR or active AHA - (Canadian Bred/US owned) registration certificate – front & back..
4. For the purpose of qualifications for the Nationals and AHA programs, **WCB** will have the same status, rules and membership requirements as any Regional Championship show. (Refer to current AHA Handbook)
5. **Non-Canadian owned horses can be shown as long as the horse was Canadian Bred which must be on the registration certificate.**

Eligibility item to compete in EC & AHA recognized show

1. All riders, drivers, owners, lessees, agents, or trainers who are a member of EC and A.H.A.
2. Any individual participating in this show must hold an Equestrian Canada Sport Horse license in good standing. Entries need to be accompanied by a copy of the EC; and provincial; sport horse license card along with amateur status if applicable.
3. Any individual participating in this show must be a member of the Arabian Horse Association- in good standing. Entries need to be accompanied by a copy of the AHA membership card with legible number & year.
4. All exhibitors at the age of nineteen and over who are competing in Amateur classes must be eligible for Amateur status as described in the current EC Rule Book and must also have a current EC Amateur Competition License. The Amateur status must be applied & paid for each year along with a sport horse license. Refer to the current EC Rulebook.
5. Any person who has not reached their 19th birthday is regarded as an Amateur and is called a JUNIOR. Junior exhibitors must also have a current membership in EC if showing in a regional level show & AHA. Junior exhibitors must have signatures of Parent or Guardian on entry form in all signature areas. – ie: rider, owner and minor consent. EC Article 216
6. Combined ownership is **not** allowed in Amateur Owner classes unless all owners are members of the immediate family. See the EC Glossary in Book A for the definition of “immediate” family.
7. Substitutions may be allowed provided the request is made in writing to the WCB Commission prior to the start of the show.

OTHER SHOW INFORMATION

1. **Barn calls** are a courtesy only. Exhibitors are responsible for being ready to show when their class begins.
2. **Gate hold** will be granted at the discretion of Show Management. Please request **ALL** gate holds through the Show Office on the appropriate form. This insures that all personnel are informed of each gate hold and the judge is not kept waiting unnecessarily. Three minutes is the maximum gate hold allowed at this show.
3. **Class Schedule:** Exhibitors must ascertain when classes are being judged. Every effort will be made to advise the exhibitors of any changes to the Tentative Schedule. Be sure to check at the show office each day to make sure you have the correct information.
4. **Halter Horses:** At the WCB Championship all In-Hand & Breeding horses will enter the show ring in an assigned order (oldest to youngest) . Judging begins when the first horse enters the ring and its movement is being evaluated and scored. The horse shall enter at a trot. The AHA MOS Halter scoring system which is “comparative” will be used at this Championship show.
5. **In Ring Procedure:** One specified person assisting with the entrance of In-Hand horses into the ring will be allowed to use only the same length of whip and appendage as is currently allowed for the individual handling the horse. Specified person will not hit or use any other objects to make any noise. The use of plastic or paper bags of any tuyepe or size is prohibited in assisting with entrace into the arena. It is the responsibility of management to advise the specified person of this policy and their role.
6. **Parking Ticket** - Parking is charged at the gate for any venue EXCEPT this horse show.
Make sure you tell the Gate Attendant that you are coming the horse show.
7. **Number of horses :** are calculated at the closing of the gate and the beginning of the class for all classes shown as a group & all those who pass through the gate in individual activity classes determines the number of horses in each class.
8. **Sport Horse In-Hand** - The Triangle Pattern must be used at AHA shows.

Exhibitors will not move from their assigned stalls without permission of the Show Commission.

Post entries – might not be able to stable with a particular group after stalls are assigned

COMPLETION OF ENTRY

1. All horses must be entered in the proper class and must be entered in the name of their bonafide owner or lessee as per the registration papers.
2. **A photocopy of the registered lease agreement must accompany entries for leased horse along with the registration certificate.**
****IMPORTANT**** ENTRY FORM. Signatures are required on the back of the entry form NOT on the front. Minors (18yrs of age & under) signatures are NOT allowed and must have a Parent/Guardian signature on all required signature lines. Please read the form carefully and fill in ALL blanks. *No more than one owner per entry form.*
3. Entries accompanied with a postdated cheque will be processed on **that** date. If this is after the closing date of entries, the entry will be considered a late entry and the double fee per class will be charged.
4. It is the responsibility of the person(s) signing the Entry Form to verify that the horse is eligible to be entered and compete in the respective Championship class.
5. Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the public address system and paddock calls over that system must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that their horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working public address system to carry class calls, however no protest will be upheld, nor will any section or class be changed on the basis of the public address system malfunctions.
6. **NOTE: Entries cannot be accepted unless accompanied with an up-to-date copy of the registration certificate**

Awards

- A Top Six will be named in each class..
- Champion & Reserve Champion will be named from the Top Six.
- The Champion, Reserve Champion and remaining Top Six will receive a ribbon and an award.

Protective Headgear

Article A905.4 states a) Junior competitors must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while mounted on competition or event grounds.

Approved headgear meets the ASTM (American Society for testing Materials) standards and displays the SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) seal. The British standard, BSI, is also acceptable.

Article A905.1 states – It is strongly recommended that all persons wear ASTM/SEI or BSI approved headgear at all times while mounted or driving cross country or marathon.

Article A802.6 states – All entry forms at competitions that are subject to the new junior headgear rule must include the following acknowledgement and ensure that the entry form is signed by the parent/guardian.

Directly from EC – “Is approved headgear compulsory for ALL junior exhibitors? At present, if the junior is competing in a discipline or breed whose rules specify other headgear (e.g. western hats, derbies etc) those rules supersede the new rule. However, all breeds and disciplines do allow protective headgear with no penalty and we urge their members to put safety ahead of tradition and adopt the new rule. Therefore, no helmets are mandatory as yet in Saddle Seat or Western classes but they are recommended. Approved headgear is mandatory in all over fence classes.

WESTERN CANADIAN BREEDERS CHAMPIONSHIP

June 27 – July 1, 2018

It is the mandate of the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry to promote the breeding of quality Arabian horses in Canada.

Judging

- The Western Canadian Breeder Championship Classes are judged according to the current Equestrian Canada current rulebook, Arabian division.
- All classes will hold the same winning level as received in a Regional Championship show and are recognized by A.H.A. All awards are accredited the same rights and privileges for National competition qualification and achievement award points.
- IAB Sweepstake points are earned at the Class A Level in this show and are eligible only for year-end payback. No Regional level sweepstake prize money will be paid from Western Canadian Breeders show.
- Western Canadian Breeders Classes will be judged by a panel of three judges.

Membership

- Membership requirements for the Western Canadian Breeders is the same as required for a Regional or National show. Refer to the membership section of this prize list for those rules.

Judging Systems

COMP 606. MAJORITY OPINION SYSTEM (MOS) - This system will be used for all performance classes except Working Western, Dressage & Sport Horse
The Majority Opinion System (MOS) is a method of scoring judges cards for a multi-judge panel where each judge has the power of one full vote to place all competitors in a class. Final placings are scored by at least a two-thirds majority of those votes favorable to each place being awarded. All judges tie the same number of entries per class, that number depending on the number of entries in the class.

Using this system, all classes will be judged by three judges. These three judges and their cards are designated as Number One (A), Number Two (B) and Number Three (C).

The Number One (Call) Judge is appointed in rotation and the three judges rotate their positions in the ring for each class.

Each judge will judge independently with no conferring (except in the presence of the Ringmaster when a workout is to be called) until the cards are handed in.

Ties are resolved by the two-thirds majority vote opinion of the three judges.

The United Professional Horsemen's Association (UPHA) Arabian Breeds Challenge Cup will resolve a three way identical tie for first place by a mandatory workout of the tied exhibitors. If the tie is not resolved after the workout, the class is determined by the Fall of the Cards.

The judges cards will be posted. A computer will be utilized during the show.

*****NEW: WCB will be using only the MOS scoring system for all In Hand & Breeding halter classes which does not utilize the "scorecard" but is a comparative system only.**

WORKING HUNTER (Refer to current AHA Handbook)

Enter Class #800 for Warm-up round on entry form.

Schooling Rounds - Warm-up Hunter - is **NOT** an AHA qualifying class but simply "Hunter Schooling Rounds". Fences to be set to accommodate the ATR Hunter over Fence class with heights not to exceed 2'6" and spreads not to exceed the width of the fence.

This warm-up time is **not** run as per EC Arabian Warm-up Hunter Rules.

Rounds are **NOT** judged. **Warm-up rounds** – limited to one round per horse per class with a maximum of 3 minutes in total per rider. – fee \$5.00 per schooling round per rider. Time is limited for Warm-up Rounds.

WCB Working Hunter Classes shall consist of only one section per class. Sections B & C will not be offered.

Top 6 placing horses plus two reserve horses shall be jogged in according to the judge's preference order, dismounted and judged for soundness following each over fence class.
